Sisters Barbara Bush and Jenna Bush Hager may have been born into a famous family, but each is a leader in her own right.

At <u>Leadercast Women</u> 2018, Barbara and Jenna shared that kindness, empathy and humility are qualities that leaders must emulate. The sisters said these traits, along with leading with love, are essential. "There is a lot of fear-based rhetoric out there right now. That's not leadership," Barbara explained.

Jenna expressed that well-defined boundaries are critical to strong leadership as well. "Work hard but not so hard that you can't enjoy conversations with your kids," Jenna said. "Say no to some things. Find your own voice and learn the power of no."

Barbara blazed her own trail in the global health field as co-founder and former CEO of the Global Health Corps. "I didn't see myself as a co-founder or CEO. I saw a problem I wanted to solve," she said. "The label felt so funny, but I had to do something that felt out of my comfort zone in order to make a dent in the issues I cared about."
