GRANTS GIVER (\$2,500): Grantmaking by women for women and girls is at the heart of what our agency was founded upon in 2004. Our involvement in providing funding for partnering nonprofit agencies has evolved significantly over the years with \$322,000+ invested locally. Choosing this level of support means you help us assist 15 to 20 other agencies annually in service to women and girls in our community.

We unveiled a second grantmaking cycle in 2022, committing to three-year
Strategic Grantmaking partnerships of \$5,000 annually with two organizations: Ebony Vision
and Fondy C.A.R.E.S. We have moved our regular grantmaking, with smaller programming grants,
to the spring to coincide with the shift of our fiscal year. Giving to the Women's Fund ensures
your gift supports women and girls through a grantee vetting process, as well as required grantee reports
on the success of programming related to the use of grant dollars. Good stewardship and oversight:
Two key benefits of giving directly to our agency vs. individual donations to many agencies.
